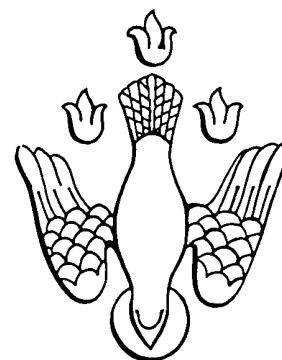
### Foreign Coin Scheme
