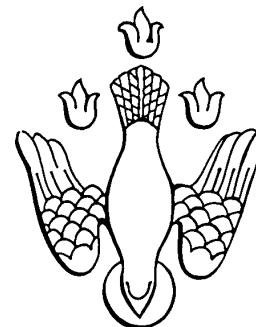
### Refectory Quiz - Wednesday 14 May at 6.30pm
