WAYS TO GIVE

Parish Giving Scheme

The Parish Giving Scheme (PGS) is a secure and simple way of giving to the Cathedral on a regular monthly basis (or quarterly/annually if you prefer). The scheme enables the Cathedral to plan ahead, allowing us to know how much money is pledged in any given year. It is also administered externally, which lessens the administrative burden on our staff. If you are not already giving to the Cathedral, this is the best way to begin to do so.

PGS works by making a Direct Debit from your bank account on the 1st of the month, which is credited to the Cathedral's bank account by the 10th of the month. If eligible, you can opt to add Gift Aid, which PGS claims on our behalf, passing it back to us and benefitting our cashflow.

A unique feature of the scheme is the option for you, as a giver, to commit in principle to increase your gift annually in line with inflation. While this is a voluntary decision, it is one that could potentially have a huge impact on the life and future of the Cathedral. You can change this commitment at any time, either by using your personal log-in on the PGS website, or simply by contacting the PGS team. For those who have accepted the inflation link, the annual increase happens on the anniversary of the first donation.

To set up a regular gift with PGS, either

You will need to provide your bank details, and use Guildford Cathedral's unique code, which is 170617001
