As you go around look out for these pictures and put a tick when you see them

*Walk carefully to the end of the Car Park and continue around to the end of the Cathedral until you see a **HUGE** cross!*

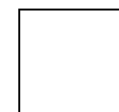


The cross was put up to mark the spot where the Cathedral would be built. It is made from the wood of an old Royal Navy ship called 'HMS Ganges'.



This end of cathedral houses the Lady Chapel. Outside there are four statues of Ladies.

Walk a little way past the statues until you can get a clear view of the tower. Look up.



The golden angel

Carry on walking around the Cathedral until you get to the next set of doors.

Notice that some of the drainpipes have the Bishop's mitre and the date they were put in place stamped on them in Roman Numerals.

Carry on walking around the Cathedral until you get to the next set of doors.



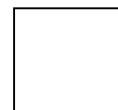
The doors show men and women doing everyday work.

Hope Courage Justice
Charity Faith Prudence

Now walk around to the front of the Cathedral and stand by the West Doors.



The statues on the front are of the Christ in the middle and on either side men and women chosen because their lives reflected the Holy Spirit.
