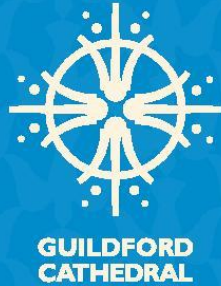

Organist Repertoires

There is no guarantee that the time preference will be met, however if your piece is played the sponsorship will be accepted.
