Holy Week in the Cathedral

During Holy Week we will be reflecting on the Diocesan theme of 'becoming prayerful, confident disciples in daily life' and using the Lord's Prayer as the basis of each of the daily Addresses. We are very grateful to the church schools which made our Stations of the Cross, which are displayed in the aisles. The children also put together prayers and questions about the line of the Lord's Prayer they used in the making of their cross.

Take your used plastic bottles and containers to The Farm Shop at Sutton Green Garden Centre (on the right hand side of Woking Rd when leaving Guildford) and stock up with washing up liquid, laundry washing liquid, fabric softener, shampoo, surface cleaners and so on. Prices are very reasonable and any plastic container can be used. In addition to reusing your plastic you can shop for fresh vegetables, fruit, eggs, local honey and meat.
