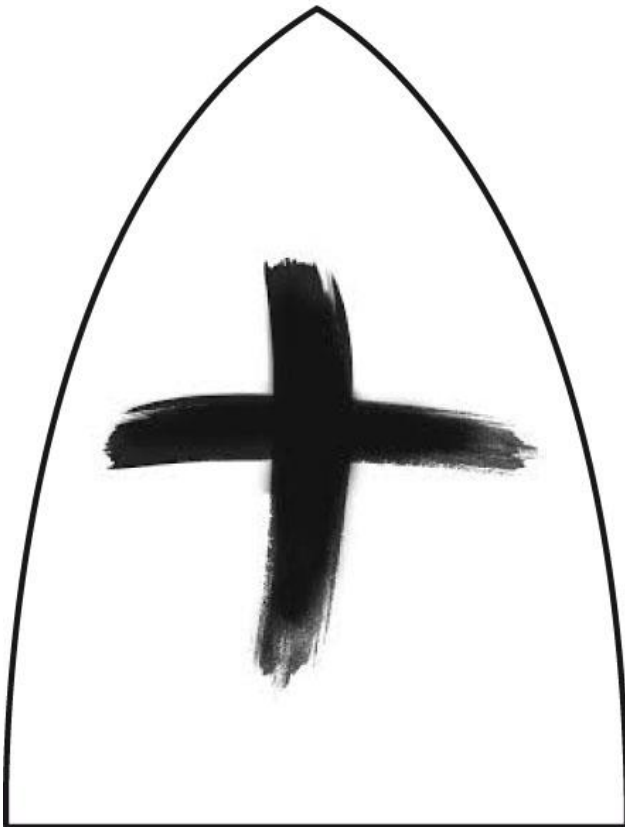

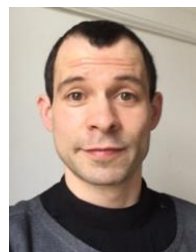
## **CHORAL EVENSONG with THE COLLATION AND INSTALLATION OF THE ARCHDEACON OF SURREY**
