

INTRODUCING OUR HOLY WEEK PREACHER, FATHER CHARLIE ANNIS CR

It is a while since we have invited a speaker to reside with us throughout Holy Week, to preach and offer reflections on the journey that Jesus took from Palm Sunday to Easter Day. This year we are delighted that Fr Charlie Annis CR will be with us, to help us to engage more deeply in this moving and profound time of the Church's year. Fr Charlie CR is a brother of



the Community of the Resurrection, Mirfield. He took his simple vows eighteen months ago and is currently studying Carmelite spirituality. Before joining the Community, he was a parish priest in Oldham, Lancs.
